 General description Fairly robust, mid green leaves with lush appearance.

Flowering, early, mid or late: early.

 Colour

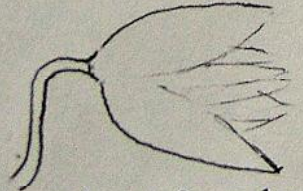
Upper surface	Lower surface
Mid Green 146A	146 B.

Features; hairiness, veining, etc.
 Short erect hairs on veins upper surface. Longer hairs on lower surface, bent flat, esp. on veins. Matt upper surface glossy lower. Semi rugose.

Notes

Stem/petiole features: Green with light purple/bronze flush on exposed side.

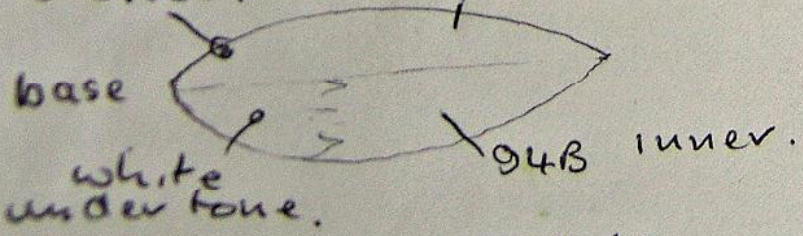
Inflorescence:
 Flower shape



Bud shape and colour: Bronze/purple.
 pale hairs on tip half of bud
 Width of flower 75 mm



Number, shape and colour of sepals: 4
 bronze flush. 94B ~~upper~~ outer



Number, shape and colour of staminodes:
 Outer 14
 Inner 40
 Half length of sepals slightly longer than
 sepals. Colour 94B
 Greenish white and with white
 under tone esp. at base.
 Colour, length orientation of peduncle 85mm
 Green with heavy bronze flush.

Length of flower 48 mm

Description of flower, including stance, etc:
 Semi double appearance,
 Slightly nodding to patent.
